Context



- European Supervisory Authorities (ESA's) define XBRL taxonomies
 - for EU-wide reporting
 - Mandatory for reporting from NCA to ESA
 - Suggested for reporting from institutions to NCA
- ▶ Banking supervision : European Banking Authority (EBA) °2014
- Insurance supervision: European Insurance and Occupational Pensions Authority (**EIOPA**) °2015
- European Central Bank (ECB) collects data from Financial Institutions in the eurozone based on EBA and EIOPA taxonomies
- Some NSAs develop local taxonomies for additional reporting

Taxonomies are implemented across Europe by supervisory authorities, submitters and software providers.






EIOPA Taxonomy Proposed Lifecycle

EIOPA Filing Rules - Miscellaneous



- No facts may be empty or nil.
- A typed dimension without value must have xsi:nil="true" (or sometimes set to "None" if no entity identification exists).
- All reported facts must correspond to a positive filing indicator.
- Reference date for Day One reporting must be 2015-12-31.
- Multiple currencies may be requested in instances.
- A processing instruction should be used to define the software component used to generate the XBRL instance; E.g.:
 - <?xml version="1.0" encoding="UTF-8"?>
 - <?instance-generator id="ACME Generator" version="2.0.1"?>
 - <xbr/>thi:xbrl...
- Other informations may appear in this instruction. E.g.:
 - <?instance-generator id="ACME Generator" version="2.0.1" option="optimize: yes"?>
 - <!-- Creation_date : 2015-11-12T17:26:17Z -->



EIOPA Use of New Specifications




- Assertion severity 1.0 (currently Proposed Recommendation 2015-11-18)
 Anticipated for Taxonomy version 2.0.2
- Extensible Enumerations 1.0 (Recommendation 2014-10-30)
 Already used in Taxonomy V1.5.2



EBA: Banking Supervision



- Go-live in 2014 with the second wave (2.0) of COREP and FINREP
- Several iterations of XBRL frameworks (2.1, 2.2, 2.3)
- On the roadmap: 2.4 and 2.5 (timing depends on legislation makers!)
- Technical evolutions
 - Moving up to new XBRL specifications (enumerations, table, etc.)
 - Multi-currency reporting as from 2016 (fact unit = fact dimension)



- Heavily used across EUROPE
- Frequent updates on validation rules
- Two years in production
- Reaching sufficient maturity level
