- Extraction of entries in XBRL GL (real business data)
- Audit and tax audit performed on the data
- Parties: Tax administration, KPMG and Fennoa (accounting system)
- Future goal to have standardized system interfaces for all ERP data



XBRL GL ADOPTION IN ESTONIA - REPORTING 3.0 PROJECT

- Lead by the Estonian Tax Office
- Mandatory Salary and workforce taxation and statistics from 1.1.2018:
- 411 unrefined reporting items over all reports gathered by different Offices
- * At least 151 different entry items needed
- * After analyzing and using XBRL GL standardization we collect only 30 items
- Next steps 2018-2020:
- All other statistical and taxation reporting
- Currently working on VAT declaration
